

Information pursuant to Art. 13 General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for applicants

Compliance with data protection regulations is a high priority for our company. In the following we would like to inform you about the collection of your personal data by us:

Data we need:

When you apply, we process the data from you that we require as part of your application. This can be contact data, all data in connection with the application (curriculum vitae, certificates, qualifications, answers to questions, etc.). The legal basis for this is § 26 of the Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG).

Data transfer to third countries:

Our company has a French parent company that operates internationally. Personnel responsibilities can exist across departmental, corporate and national boundaries. For this reason, your application documents may also be forwarded to the responsible supervisors in France, the USA or Brazil, insofar as these data processing operations are necessary in accordance with § 26 BDSG to decide on the establishment of an employment relationship. If data is transferred to the USA and Brazil, this is protected by so-called EU standard contract clauses.

Data erasure:

If no legal retention period exists, the data will be deleted as soon as storage is no longer necessary or the legitimate interest in storage has expired. If no recruitment takes place, this is usually the case no later than six months after completion of the application procedure.

In individual cases, the storage of individual data may take longer due to legal storage obligations. The duration of the storage then depends on the respective legal storage obligations, e.g. from the German Tax Code (6 years) or the German Commercial Code (10 years).

If there has been no recruitment, but your application is still of interest to us, we will ask you whether we may retain your application for future vacancies.

Confidential treatment of your data:

Your data will of course be treated confidentially and will not be passed on to third parties.

We may use service providers who are strictly bound by instructions and who support us in areas such as IT or the archiving and destruction of documents and with whom separate contracts for order processing have been concluded.

Your data protection rights:

As the person concerned, you have the right to information about the personal data concerning you and to correction of incorrect data or deletion if one of the reasons stated in Art. 17 General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) applies, e.g. if the data is no longer required for the purposes pursued.

There is also the right to restrict the processing if one of the conditions specified in Art. 18 GDPR is met and in the cases specified in Art. 20 GDPR the right to data transferability.

Every data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if he or she is of the opinion that the processing of data concerning him or her violates data protection provisions. In particular, the right of appeal may be exercised before a supervisory authority in the Member State in which the person concerned is staying or working or in which the presumed infringement occurred.
